THE POW WOW GAMES

Show off your shooting skills and abilities at the 22 cal rifle range and the BB-Gun range. This event will test the individual's shooting accuracy.

Small Bore Rifle & BB Gun Range

Description: **Discovery Rangers** – boys will shoot an **Air Rifle/BB gun** with father's / Commander's supervision.

Description: **Adventure/Expedition Rangers** - boys will shoot a **.22 rifle** for accuracy.

All rules and regulations for the shooting range will be determined by the Range Officer. Any infractions with regards to range safety will be handled by the DRO and the Camp Commander. There are no "three strikes and you're out" when it comes to firearms. Any boy or adult who fails to abide by the rules of the range will be asked to leave the range site immediately.



Archery

An outdoor youth archery range will be set-up with approximately 6 to 8 shooting lanes. The 80 cm targets will be located approximately 7 to 8 yards in front of shooting line and the arrow stop curtain will be located about 1 foot behind the targets. Only the Genesis and Mini Genesis bows and NASP 1820 arrows will be used during this event provided by the MBA. All shooting of the bows will be instinctive (no sights) and finger release. The Royal Rangers will be given individual instructions on the "11 Steps to Archery Success". The groups of shooters will be rotated in and out after five arrows are shot. At a time to be determined the different Royal Rangers Outpost patrols

will be scored using five arrows shot at the 80 cm target and scored according to the 10 ring method of scoring.



Kayak Race

This is another popular water sport turned competition. Participants will paddle to designated stations and return to the finishing point. This will be a timed competition. Kayaks, life jackets, and paddles will be provided.



Horseshoes

This year in keeping with our theme we will have horseshoes. Different sizes of actual horseshoes will be available for throwing at marked distances. 1 point for close, 2 for a leaner, 3 for a ringer.



Rope the Duck

This year will feature a new event....Duck Roping. Group 1 will paddle a canoe while towing an inflatable duck. Group two will have three Rangers in it. Two will paddle and the third will attempt to rope the duck. **Outposts required to attend.** Top points for this event is to use the lasso provided and only those who perform correctly get maximum points.



Bicycle Pole Bending

This event is to take the bicycle and weave in between cones & noodles as fast as you can without tipping them over. Bicycles and helmets will be provided. Do not bring your own bicycle, you may use your own helmet if desired. *****Outpost attendance required*****
